

Tuning Your Guitar

You can get a low E (6th string) from a piano, or another player, but as long as the instrument is tuned to itself, you can play.

Play the sixth string, fingered at the fifth fret, compare it to the sound of the open fifth string. Repeat across all the strings.

The fingered note should sound the same as the next open string.

As you see, the G string is fingered at the fourth fret.
